Jesus calls Peter and each of us to this spiritual center where we may have an elevated form of consciousness. It takes long-term, continual effort to sustain this consciousness. Why? Because our egos like to be in charge and crowd out our spiritual consciousness.

Remember, Peter who, at first, would not let Jesus wash his feet. Remember Peter when he denied he knew Jesus because his own safety was in jeopardy. That was ego, not Jesus-consciousness.

How is our ego dislodged? Loving deeply! Loving another mysteriously supplants our selfish ego. We know that from our life experiences. Such it is with Jesus and ourselves.

Jesus used that fact when he asked Peter the triple "do you love me?" If we have love in our spiritual center, replacing ego, then we have salt; we have light in our gut.

It is likely that Jesus saw a large ego in Peter and knew that if Peter could supplant his ego with a clear love of Jesus the Christ in his heart/gut, he would be an outstanding leader. He would be able to feed Jesus' lambs and feed his sheep. When Jesus saw that Peter acknowledged him, he could and did say for the second time: "Follow me."

We are faced with the same question. Will we love and allow Jesus the Christ to transform our gut from being egoistic to "Living Jesus"? That is the major question of Eastertide.



#### THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

#### First Reading: Acts 5:27-32, 40b-41

The high priest chastised Peter and the other apostles for continuing to preach when they had been ordered to stop. Peter replied he would rather obey God than men, considering God's power even over death. They are again warned to stop speaking of Jesus, and then freed.

#### Second Reading: Revelation 5:11-14

John had a vision of many angels and all the living creatures of the world gathered around a throne. The angels cried out that the slain Lamb was worthy of receiving power, glory and praise. Then every creature on earth called out praise to God and the Lamb, and the elders fell down and worshipped.

#### Gospel: John 21:1-19

Jesus appeared to the disciples for the third time since his resurrection while they were fishing. They hadn't caught anything, and then Jesus advised them to cast their net from the other side of the boat. When they did this, they caught a great number of fish. Jesus then asked Peter three times, "Do you love me?" When Peter said he did, Jesus asked him to tend and feed his sheep.

#### THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

"So he said to them: 'cast the net over the right side of the boat and you will find something.' So they cast it and were not able to pull it in because of the number of fish. So the disciple, whom Jesus loved, said to Peter, 'It is the Lord.'...Jesus said to them, 'Come and have breakfast.' Jesus came over and took the bread and gave it to them and in like manner the fish. This was the third time..."


This event, added to the conclusion of John's gospel, finds Jesus telling the fishermen what to do. They responded and were successful. Remember this is the Jesus who told Peter he would be the fisher of men. The passage concludes with Jesus giving the promised power and role to Peter of feeding the flock and following Him.

Today, we are to recast our nets, to bring those wavering in the practice of the faith, to return to the Lord. If I do not invite them, perhaps they will never respond. He invites us to another meal with Him, a breakfast. Remember the last supper, the dinner at Simon's house and with Zacchaeus. Jesus wants others to join us at Eucharist. Today, cast your net and invite someone to come home.
