At first Jesus seems to put the Canaanite woman off and told her, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel". The woman was insistent and said, "Please, Lord, for even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their masters".

Jesus praises her for her faith. He grants her request, for his message was now reaching beyond the people of Israel.

#### First Reading: Isaiah 56:1, 6-7


The Lord wants all people to love and honor his name. He says that those who honor him by obeying all of his laws will be "made joyful in my house of prayer."

A Canaanite woman begged Jesus to help her daughter, who was being plagued by a demon. Jesus at first refused her and said that "My mission is only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." The woman was so persistent that Jesus said she had great faith and then he healed her daughter.


